**AT THE WATER'S EDGE:** Buffers at the water's edge prevent erosion, reduce ice damage, intercept pollutants, and provide crucial habitat for wildlife.



**IN YOUR YARD:** Rain gardens are small planted depressions that manage rain from downspouts and hard areas at home. Managing rainfall at home reduces stress on stormwater infrastructure and improves water quality in our lakes, rivers and streams.


